

1. Sunday Morning Worship Service

9:00-10:20am

In the Youth Center

- After snacks and fellowship we have a time of corporate worship, prayer, and Bible teaching. High School and Junior High students meet together. We highly encourage students to join us in the main Sunday service at 10:45am.

2. Thursday evening Youth Group

6:30-8:30pm

In the Youth Center

- Our time together includes snacks and fellowship, group games, and a guided discussion pertaining to living a life of faith in Jesus Christ. Most of the time, we keep High School and Junior High students together. For parents, this may also afford you the opportunity to be a part of our Thursday evening Men's or Women's bible study after you drop your student off for Youth Group.

3. Small Groups

Monthly

Various locations

- Small Groups meet about once a month, but the purpose and focus of these groups is to study God's Word daily and connect through text, facebook, email, etc. for encouragement and accountability. Small group leaders will be in regular contact with your child should they choose to participate. Each small group will schedule monthly meetings at a time and location that is most convenient for the group. It may be at church, someone's house, or another location.

4. Special Events

Monthly

- Special Events include service projects (day trips and overnight trips) as well as weekend retreats. We also have fun activities at church like movie and game nights, as well as off-site activities in the greater Portland area to Bullwinkles Family Fun Center, water parks, bowling outings, etc. Our special events are usually High School -or- Junior High events (not together). Special events typically cost money, so we try to inform you in advance of the dates and costs. Scholarships are always available – please talk to the youth staff if one is needed.

5. Individual Discipleship

- Our desire is to see each student in our youth group connected with at least two adults in our church congregation who they regularly are in contact with about life and faith. This can be a regularly occurring "meeting" for mentoring and discipleship, or informal conversations at church or through technology. We encourage our youth staff to reach out to students in this way, but to ask for parental permission first.
