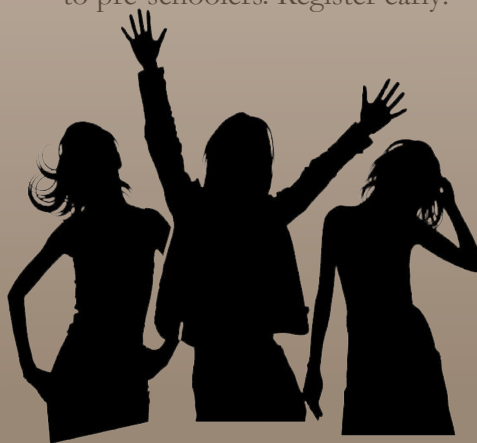

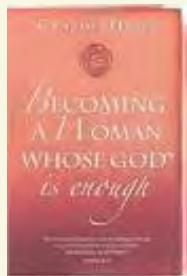

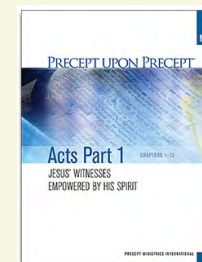
STUDIES FOR OUR WINTER TERM
