Big Picture Question and Support Verse

What does God know?

God knows everything about the past, present, and future.

1 John 3:20b says: *"...for God is greater than our hearts, and he knows all things."*

Who was David’s greatest descendant? – Matthew 1:1

Big Picture Question and Support Verse

How is Jesus the perfect King?

Jesus perfectly rules over everything.

Revelation 17:14 says: *“These will make war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will conquer them because he is Lord of lords and King of kings. Those with him are called, chosen, and faithful.”*

The Cycle of Judges

Key Verse – 1 John 1:9

“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

Why did Israel continue to sin? – Psalm 14:2-3a

“The Lord looks down from heaven on the human race to see if there are any who is wise, one who seeks God. All have turned away; all alike have become corrupt.”

Big Picture Question and Support Verse

What is repentance?

Repentance is turning away from sin and turning to Jesus.

Joel 2:13 says: *“Tear your hearts, not just your clothes, and return to the Lord your God. For he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger, abounding in faithful love, and he relents from sending disaster.”*

Samuel and King Saul

Key Verse – Jeremiah 10:6

“Lord, there is no one like you. You are great; your name is great in power.”

What does God require? – 1 Samuel 15:22b & 23b

“Look: to obey is better than sacrifice, to pay attention is better than the fat of rams.... Because you have rejected the Word of the Lord, He has rejected you as king.”

Big Picture Question and Support Verse

Is there anything or anyone greater than God?

No, God is greater than everything and everyone.

Exodus 34:6b-7a says: *“The LORD-The LORD is a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger and abounding in faithful love and truth, maintaining faithful love to a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity, rebellion, and sin. But he will not leave the guilty unpunished...”*
